REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

The prospective student is required to write an essay of approximately 500 words (150 words for Year 7) on 'What I Would like to Achieve in School'. This should be hand-written and not done on a computer.

Please send this with your completed application form, two recent passport size photographs, and your £50 registration fee. We will require copies of your child's latest reports and SAT's results where applicable and when available.

When we are in receipt of the completed application forms arrangements can be made for your son/daughter to visit the school and to take the entrance tests.

COURSES OFFERED

Secondary School

Students wishing to enter Secondary School are required to take an Ability Assessment in English, Maths and Science. Successful students may enter the school in Year 7 (age 11) and follow the national curriculum leading to GCSE qualifications in Year 11 or International Baccalaureate in Year 13. Enrolment as a Day Student, Flexible Boarder, 5 Day Boarder or 7 Day Boarder is possible. Only students aged 11 to 14 may apply to the Secondary School.

International School

This course is offered to students who wish to continue their studies according to the British curriculum or improve their English Language (ESL). The International School is ideal for those students who intend to study at a British or American University. Entry is by Ability Assessment, which may include an ESL paper for non-native speakers. Students aged 11 to 18 may apply for this course. ESL tuition ensures all non native speakers obtain proficiency. All students will have the opportunity to sit a Cambridge Examination.
